NC seeks speedy implementation of schemes for OBC, ST communities



Jammu : National Conference today urged the administration to focus on the implementation of various schemes aimed at ameliorating the lot of weaker sections of the society in Jammu and Kashmir.

"There has been slow pace on the implementation of welfare schemes for OBC and ST segments of the society, which need priority attention of the Lt Governor's administration," Provincial President National Conference Rattan Lal Gupta said while interacting with the delegation of these communities from Udampur led by Anayatullah District President OBC Cell and Mohd Gani District President ST Cell.

Gupta recalled the relentless efforts made by National Conference led governments under Dr Farooq Abdullah and Omar Abdullah as Chief Minister towards the welfare and empowerment of Scheduled Caste and Other Backward Classes and said these received severe dent during the past few years.

Gupta referred to various issues flagged by the delegation related to the empowerment of these communities and one time issuance of the OBC Certificate on the analogy of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe categories, saying these merit immediate consideration by the government. He said political empowerment to these communities has remained core of the National Conference agenda over the decades as the party believes that their greater involvement in the decision making will go a long way in promoting harmonious growth of the society.

Seers of two Akhadas at loggerheads over control of Veni Madhav Temple

PRAYAGRAJ :

Two factions of seers from Shripanchayati Akhada Mahanirwani and Juna Akhada are at odds over control of the ancient and revered Veni Madhav Temple in Prayagraj's Daraganj area. The Hindu monastic orders are known as akhadas. Following the recent death of the temple priest, both factions attempted to seize control of the temple, which is dedicated to Lord Vishnu and his consort Goddess Lakshmi.



and demanded the removal of temple mahant Vibhuti Narayan Tripathi, who belongs to Juna Akhada. Soon after, seers from the opposing group gathered at the temple, resulting in a brawl. After receiving information, Daraganj police intervened and managed to restore order.

Following a standoff, the district police and administration were forced to intervene, and the temple, which is close to Sangam, has been closed for the time being. Both factions have been asked to present documents to the authorities in support of their demands.

On Sunday night, a group of seers from Shripanchayati Akhada Mahanirwani entered the temple premises

the lockdown period without informing him. They later discovered that, with the exception of Umashankar Giri and Prabhat Giri, all other seers had been expelled from the temple. Vibhuti Narayan Tripathi declared himself mahant "illegally" and used funds from the Kumbh for temple renovations worth Rs. 97 lakh.

Raghubar Giri's guru was Mahant Purushottam Giri, who appointed Omkar Giri as mahant of the Veni Madhav Temple. Prior to 2013, Mahanirwani Akhada was in charge of Veni Madhav Temple, but Juna Akhada later appointed Omkar Giri as mahamandaleswar. Following his death, Vibhuti Narayan Tripathi was given responsibility for the temple, which triggered a dispute over temple control between Mahanirwani and Juna Akhada seers, according to a senior seer aware of the developments.

DoT revises policy for issue/renewal of NOC for sale/rent of International Roaming SIM Cards



New Delhi : As part of the policy reforms initiated in telecom sector, the Department of Telecom (DoT) has issued the "Revised terms & conditions for issue/renewal of NOC for sale/rent of International Roaming SIM Cards/ Global Calling Cards of Foreign Operators in India." The revised terms & conditions have been finalized by DoT after deliberations on the Suo-motu Recommendations of TRAI on Sale/rent of International Roaming SIM Cards/ Global Calling Cards of foreign operators in India. The revised terms & conditions strengthens the mechanism to protect the interests of the Indian public visiting abroad and also streamlines the procedures in line with the other licenses/registrations.

The revised policy mandates the NOC holders to make provision for providing information regarding customer care service, contact details, escalation matrix, itemised bills, information related to tariff plans, services offered, etc. Provision has also been made to strengthen Billing and consumer grievance redressal mechanism to facilitate time bound resolution of grievance by the NOC holders with provision for Appellate Authority in DOT. Further, the revised policy also streamlines the application process/ other procedures for the NOC holders in line with the other licenses/registrations etc. in the DOT and to facilitate the resolution/ management of the issues of the NOCs holders.
